In mid-May a group of grade 6 students from C.E. Barry School joined 82 students, parents and teachers on an overnight camping trip to the Skagit Valley with the Mountain School program. During this trip the camp served 328 meals, students saw 5 bears, had 4 deer visit the camping area, completed 4 curriculum units on the Skagit Valley, hiked in 2 countries and drank countless cups of hot chocolate with marshmallows. For 65% of the students this was their first camping experience; for 85% their first time in the Skagit Valley; for 40% it was their first trip to the USA. The camp was completed before the June-uary rains- the weather was absolutely beautiful!

Grade 6 students at C.E. Barry have been completing their "Trail Etiquette and Backcountry Safety" Course with the Mountain School this month. After learning about safety in the mountains, low impact hiking and what to do when encountering bears and cougar, the students complete a one-day hike to the Mount Hope Lookout. This course acts as an introduction to the Mountain School program and prepares students for more outdoor excursions in their grade 7 to 12 years. The grade 7's are going to be hiking Blackwall Peak and Lightning Lake in Manning Park with the Mountain School on Monday June 14<sup>th</sup>. 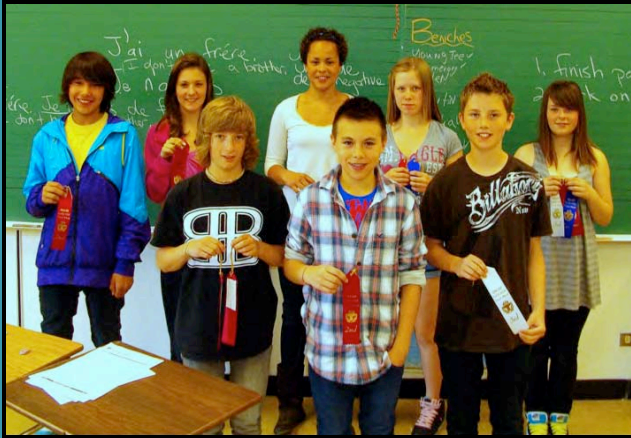
## SAFE ARRIVAL PROGRAM
