JOB DESCRIPTION

BUS DRIVER

Location: Transportation

Summary:

Under the direction and supervision of the Transportation Supervisor, operates a school bus and supervises passengers.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Transports passengers.
- Performs pre-trip and post-trip safety inspections, fuels busses, and maintains record of same in accordance with government regulations.
- Identifies and reports relevant information, such as mechanical problems, road hazards, bus overloads, and accidents.
- Supervises and monitors the conduct and behaviour of passengers; reports any misconduct in accordance with school board policy.
- Operates "Silent Witness" equipment and reviews video tape when required.
- Instructs passengers in the use of safety and emergency procedures.
- Reports traffic violations to R.C.M.P.
- Ensures bus is secure at the end of each shift.
- Washes exterior of bus, cleans and disinfects interior of bus.
- Maintains familiarity with Workplace Hazardous Materials Information System (WHMIS) and Workers Compensation Board (WCB) safety procedures.
- Performs other bus driver or emergent duties which are within the scope of knowledge, skills and abilities required by this position.
- Performs all duties with a level of interpersonal skills appropriate to the position.
- Operates school bus and uses equipment such as radio, tire chains, hand tools, video camera, power washer and other cleaning equipment.

Required Qualifications and Experience:

- High School diploma or equivalent.
- Some related driving experience.
- A valid B.C. Class 2 driver's licence with air endorsement.
- A valid Occupational First Aid Level 1 course.
- Up-to-date knowledge of traffic and safety regulations.
- Ability to work with constant interruptions.
