1.0 F.T.E. DISTRICT SUMMER SCHOOL TEACHER - TEMPORARY (0.4 FTE AESS/ 0.6 FTE HSS)

1.0 F.T.E. Temporary teacher is required for Summer School effective July 2, 2024 through July 31, 2024. **Note: This position will only be filled if there is sufficient enrollment**

Summer school will be offered from July 2 – July 31, 2024 for a total of (22) days. A hybrid model of instruction will be used where students will work on their online courses at home as well as onsite, where in-person support from a Summer School teacher will be available.

The District Summer School teachers will:

- 1. be prepared to support students working independently on academic courses from grades 8-12 in all subject areas;
- 2. demonstrate knowledge and skills applicable to teaching and learning in a Distributed Learning environment;
- 3. demonstrate knowledge of and experience using the Moodle LMS;
- 4. demonstrate effective organizational and communication skills appropriate for the Distributed Learning and online learning environment;
- 5. use technology (e.g.: computers, digital portfolios, voice-mail, e-mail, websites, MyEd BC) for communication, planning, classroom instruction and reporting purposes;
- 6. informally report students' progress to parents, as needed, during July;
- 7. formally report students' progress at the end of July (to home school and to parents);
- 8. be prepared to adapt course work to meet students' needs;
- 9. work with students who demonstrate a wide range of learning needs;
- 10. use effective written and oral interpersonal skills in both face-to-face and online settings;

MINIMUM ACADEMIC QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE:

- a) valid B.C. Teaching Certificate;
- b) Bachelor of Education degree or equivalent;
- c) experience teaching online with the Moodle platform and WCLN-sourced courses

PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE:

- a) A working knowledge of core competencies for each curricular area.
- b) Experience working with students on behaviour self-management/regulation.
