- a) Professional Teaching Certificate (BCCT) – preferred but not required;
- b) Qualified to administer and interpret up to and including Level C Educational, Psychological and Behavioural Tests;
- c) Training in Psychometric Theory and Principles;
- d) Current knowledge of Ministry of Education Special Education Policies and Procedures;
- e) Excellent communication and interpersonal skills;
- f) Experience and/or In-service/Professional Development working with Aboriginal Students, families and communities.

Demonstrated ability in the following:

- a) Consulting with teachers, parents, students and community agencies regarding the nature of student strengths and needs, educational implications and ways to enhance learning and interpersonal relations;
